- a) The Payment of the supplier would be made within 15 days upon submission of invoice along-with required documents, through Inland Letter of Credit (Sight), the cost of establishing Letter of Credit shall be borne by the coal supplier/seller, when delivered, verified and accepted quantity of the coal at the project site exceeds the ordered quantity or 15000 Metric Tons of awarded quantity and upon submission of invoices in quadruplicate along with "GDs with HS Code", "Certificate of Analysis or Laboratory Reports" and "Weight Certificate" duly signed by the Operating Committee constituted by the Procuring Agency having Suppliers' representative as member.

**7.1 Provisional/Interim Payment**


a) Payment to the Supplier shall be made within fifteen (15) days of submission of the invoice along with all required documents, either:

- through Inland Letter of Credit (Sight), in which case the cost of LC establishment shall be borne by the Coal Supplier/Seller; or
- through pay order/cheque issued by JPCL,

where the delivered, verified, and accepted quantity of coal at the project site exceeds the ordered quantity or 15,000 metric tons of the awarded quantity, and upon submission of invoices in quadruplicate together with the following documents:

- GDs with HS Codes
- Certificate of Analysis / Laboratory Test Reports
- Weight Certificate

All documents must be duly signed by the Operating Committee constituted by the Procuring Agency, in which the Supplier's representative is a member. The decision of payment either through LC or Pay order/Cheque shall be sole discretion of JPCL.

  
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		b) In case of offered quantity is less than 15,000, the payment shall be made strictly through pay order/ cheque after successful delivery of the coal required.
